- It also considers different stakeholders and target audience for the ARISE project.



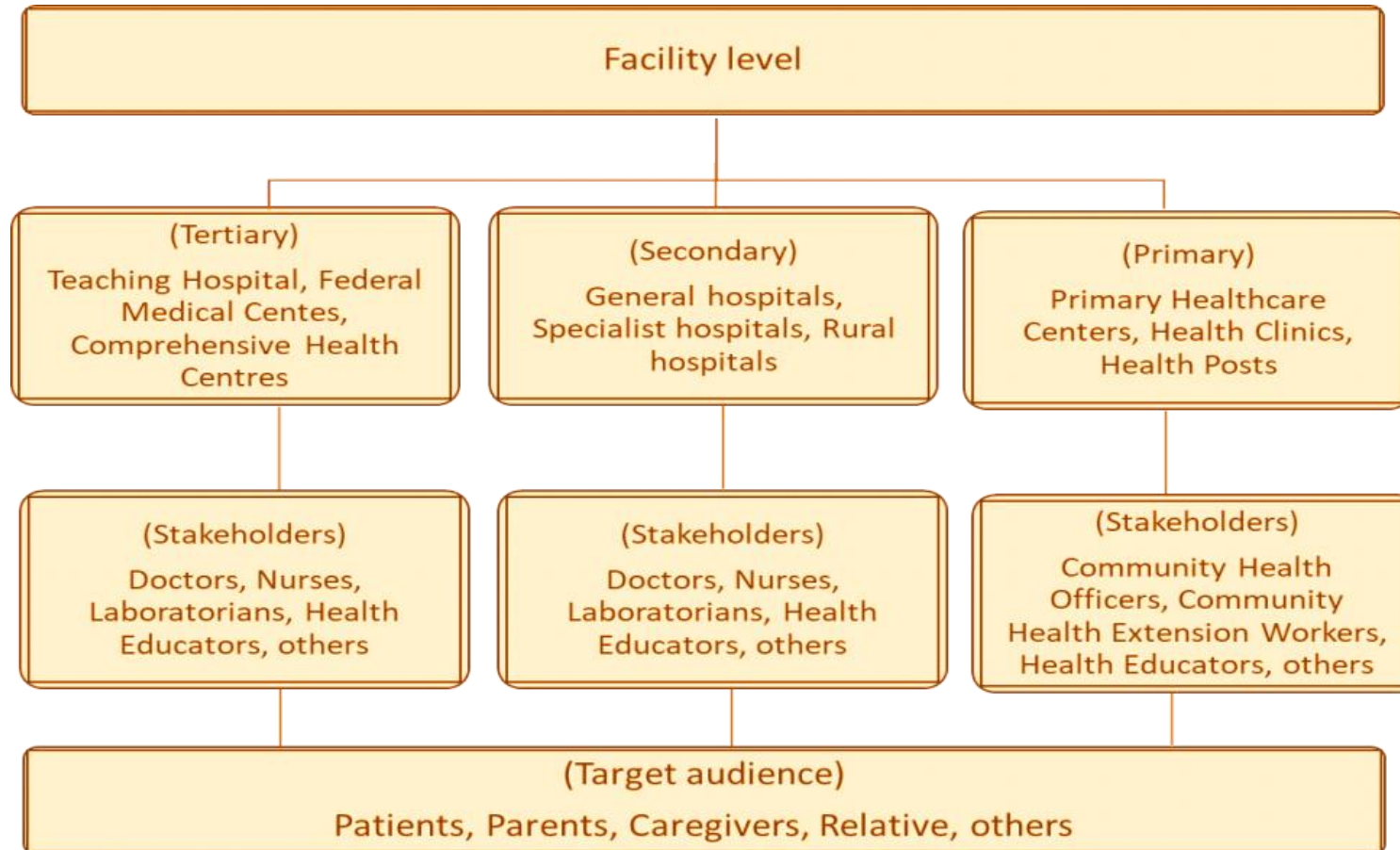
# Target/identified levels plan for implementation of ARISE project in Nigeria.
